- **5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Proposed enactment of the "Regulation for Inspection of Imported Cleansing & Hygiene Products". (11 page(s), in Korean)
- **6. Description of content:** The purpose of establishment of "Regulation for Inspection of Imported Cleansing & Hygiene Products" ("the Regulation") is to stipulate matters concerning import declaration and inspection of Cleansing & Hygiene Products according to the Cleansing & Hygiene Control Act and its Enforcement Rule.

The proposed enactment of the regulation includes the following provisions:

- 1. Disposal procedures when importers declare importation of Cleansing & Hygiene Products prior to the estimated arrival date.
- 2. Illustrate follow-up steps after conditional import declaration certificate is issued.
- 3. Notification procedures when imported Cleansing & Hygiene Products fail to meet the requirement laid down by the regulation.

- 4. Scope of Cleansing & Hygiene Products subject to distribution control per the regulation and relevant follow-up procedures.
- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Protection of human health or safety
