- 5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on ENISA, the "EU Cybersecurity Agency", and repealing Regulation (EU) 526/2013, and on Information and Communication Technology cybersecurity certification ("Cybersecurity Act") (COM(2017) 477 final/3) (and its accompanying annex) (92 pages + Annex 4 pages, in English, French and Spanish)
- **6. Description of content:** This proposal for a Regulation concerns the new mandate for ENISA, the EU cybersecurity Agency, and the establishment of a European cybersecurity certification framework.
- **7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable:** The overarching objective of the proposal is to reinforce the cyber resilience of the Union and thus foster the effective functioning of the internal market. In particular, the proposed Regulation provides for a comprehensive set of measures that build on previous actions and fosters mutually reinforcing specific objectives:
 - Increasing capabilities and preparedness of Member States and businesses;
 - Improving cooperation and coordination across Member States and EU institutions, agencies and bodies;
 - Increasing EU level capabilities to complement the action of Member States, in particular in the case of cross-border cyber crises;
 - Increasing awareness of citizens and businesses on cybersecurity issues;

- Increasing the overall transparency of cybersecurity assurance of ICT products and services to strengthen trust in the digital single market and in digital innovation; and
- Avoiding fragmentation of certification schemes in the EU and related security requirements and evaluation criteria across Member States and sectors.
